GENERAL				
<input type="checkbox"/>	No REQUIRED courses (non-business, foundation, intermediate, or advanced) may be taken on a Pass/No Pass basis (with the exception of BSAD 098, 101, 150).			
<input type="checkbox"/>	ALL majors (except ACCT) must complete an International Business Course Requirement (IBCR), which can be used in the major OR in the electives. Select from the following: ECON321,322,323,388,421,422,423,440,487, FINA450,MNGT428,MRKT453; or study abroad course work ACCT/FINA/MNGT/MRKT429, BSAD 491, ECON 466,467			
<input type="checkbox"/>	A MINIMUM of 60 hours of BUSINESS course work (taught by the College of Business Administration) must be completed for ALL majors (except ABUS & RAIKES).			
<input type="checkbox"/>	A minimum of 12 hours of 300/400-level courses must be taken outside of the business core. (ACTS majors satisfy this automatically.)			
<input type="checkbox"/>	A minimum of 120 hours of applicable college degree credit is required for the degree.			
<input type="checkbox"/>	A minimum of 30 of the last 36 credit hours for the degree must be completed in residence.

<input type="checkbox"/>	At least ONE ACE qualified course (3 hours) must be taken for each of the 10 outcomes; ACE must be satisfied by course work in at least THREE subject areas.			
<input type="checkbox"/>	An ACE course approved for more than one area can only fulfill ONE ACE outcome			
<input type="checkbox"/>	Up to THREE Ace learning outcomes 4-10 may be satisfied by work in one subject area.
