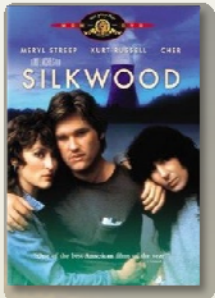

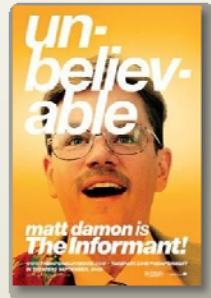
Silkwood

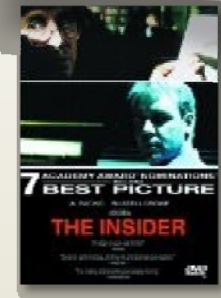
Erin Brockovich
